Give Special Time like a Connection Vitamin





Set a date
"Whatever you want"
Extra warmth, eye contact
Promote laughter
No advice

Build connection By promoting laughter in play



Hint: Playfully take the less powerful role!




PLAYLISTENING



Let child lead
Less powerful role
Notice & promote laughter
Don't tickle

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


Grandparents' Step 3
When your grandchild's behavior goes off track, connect before you correct.
Then, listen.





STAYLISTENING



Move close
Stop irrational behavior
Make time for feelings
"I care. You are safe."

Stay close when feelings are high.
Don't scold. Don't instruct.

LISTEN & let hard feelings roll.
